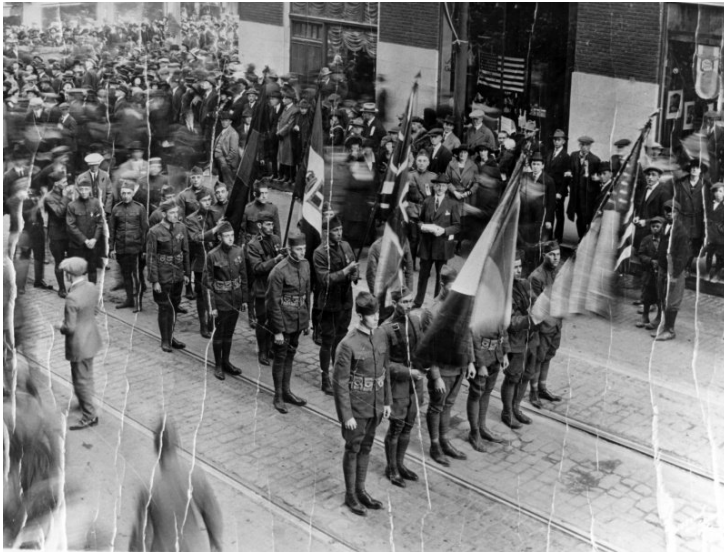




Description
