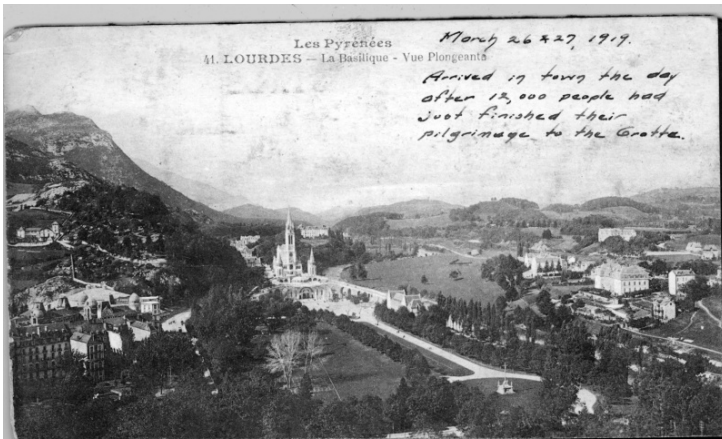




Description
