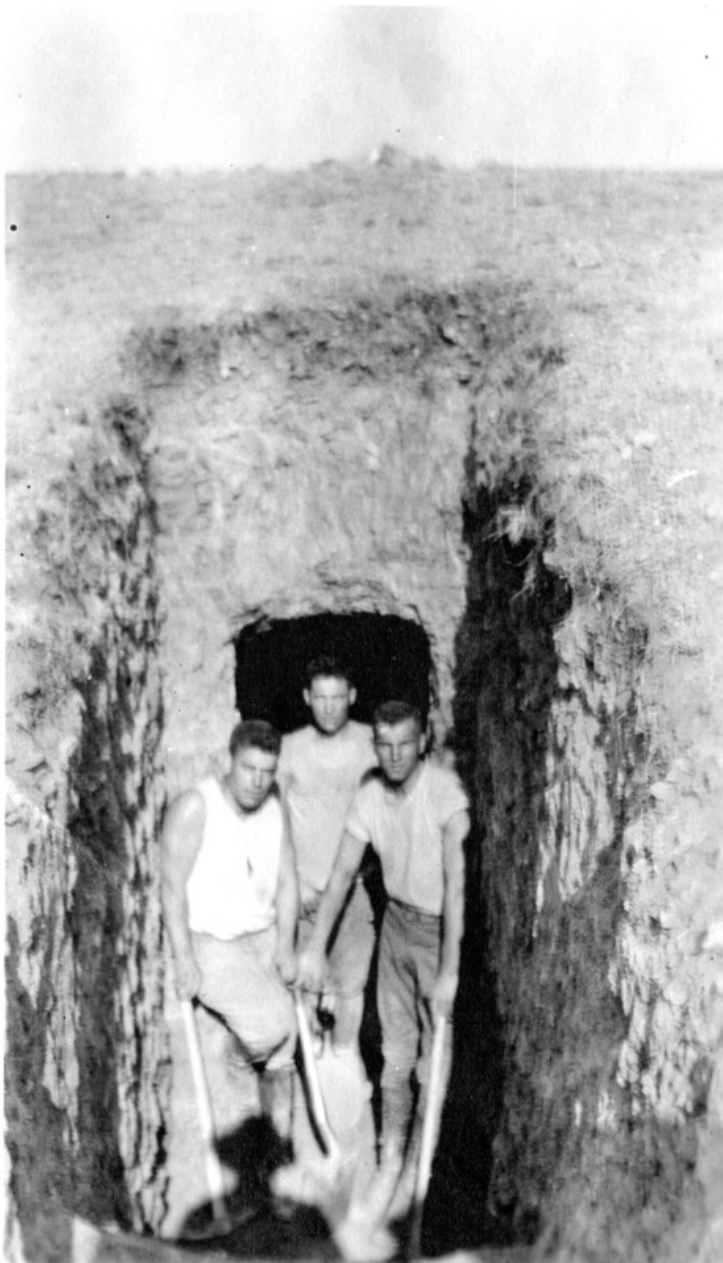


**Description**
