Mr. Connolly advised that the President has read the Lr from James A. Farley with respect to former Cong. Charles M. LaFollette and would appreciate if if Mr. Farley would check in to any political repercussions which might occur in his Congressional District if such a move were undertaken.--Lr to Mr. McGrath from Mr. Farley in Rome, 9/19/48 suggesting that President send for Rep. LaFollette, A.P.O. 124, O.M.C.W.B., Stuttgart, Germany.--Attached is memo. to Mr. Dawson from Alma Eichinger of Oct. 15th re the above. Mr. Connolly has said that he does not have time left to do this. Mr. Farley's thought that it would be well to get the views of Rep. LaFollette on European situation, Berlin, etc.
