Berlin Blockade

Sent memorandum to General McKee re their conversation concerning Air Force furnishing officer to speak to Midshipmen at Naval Academy on airlift operation to Berlin. Says he spoke to Midshipman Paul A. Garrison at Naval Academy who suggested that Air Force could make available an officer who had had personal experience with airlift and could give them picture of entire operation. Following this talk, which will be held in the Smoke Hall for their regular "Smoke Hall Panel", panel will be open to general discussion. Meeting scheduled for December 15.---On 12/20/48 Paul A. Garrison wrote Colonel Landry on behalf of the Smoke Hall panel thanking him for his help in obtaining Admiral Whitney as their speaker.
