MEMORANDUM FOR THE FILES:

Ltr of 7/12/49 to the President from Mrs. Charlotte Pugh ~~Byrn~~, Hamburg, Ark.; her husband (name not given) is in the Army Air Force and, upon being made permanent in the Air Lift in Germany, her household effects were taken over by the transportation officer at Kelly Air Base, Texas, for shipment so she and the children could join him; when the blockade was lifted (5/12/49) her "Port Call of May 31st" was canceled; the Kelly Air Base is now asking what to do with her effects and offer to store them; she and other wives would like to know just what the Army intends to do regarding their husbands and also as to whether the wives are to go to Germany or stay home; would like to know soon as her children will have to go to school; asks if it would be possible for the President to recommend more rapid decision re the personnel in Germany.
