Mr. Charles Fahy called to say that his Committee is meeting Wednesday to decide on whether or not they would agree with the release that Sec. Johnson issued last week regarding segregation in the armed forces.

Mr. Fahy would prefer that the President refrain from making any comment until after his committee meets - unless he merely says "The Army has made a step forward". He is not sure that his Committee will agree that the Army is going far enough but he will send a memo to the President just after their meeting on Wednesday.
