MEMORANDUM FOR JUDGE ROSENMAN:

Subject: Memorandum on War Crimes.

I have prepared a memorandum, copy of which is inclosed, which I designed for use at the discussions in San Francisco next week. Mr. McCloy has seen it, as has Colonel Murray G. Bernays. Both of them seem satisfied with it in its present form. However, I should suppose you would probably have some modifications to suggest. If it meets with your approval, I suggest that we have it translated in Russian and French to facilitate prompt consideration.

G-2 has a Russian translator and I will have work started on it at once. Any later changes made in the English version can be made also in the translations.
