Judge Rosenman sends following message: "I had a talk with  
President Truman who is definitely opposed to political  
disposition of top criminals. I think he would favor, how-  
ever, the Lord Chancellor's proposal. I am calling a meeting  
of the three departments concerned on afternoon 20 April.  
Suggest you communicate this to McCloy. The President has  
asked me to continue in charge of these negotiations. Would  
appreciate any latest word. Have not yet received formal  
memorandum of the Lord Chancellor."
