According to the wishes of ID, we sent the file on Goering today, copy of which is attached. The general remarks try to give a parallelism between Goering's general attitude toward the war of aggression, his lies to the public and the Allied Nations, and his cynicism in boasting of them later on. His crime against the Jewish people is shown in official propaganda, legislation, persecution of official measures, and finally in acts of theft and robbery committed in his own favor.

FROM: MR. SENDER

Enclosed is a copy of the dossier on the Mufti, sent to Washington today. As I said to you over the telephone this morning, I thought that from this presentation the tie between the terror of Haj Amin and the Axis conspiracy would emerge with much more relief than from an elaborated study. Besides, our friend told us yesterday that what is more important for him is the material rather than elaborate studies.

We insisted yesterday on obtaining a copy of his work as soon as possible, and he gave us his reassurance in this respect.

As you know, neither the Mufti nor Eichmann are among the 28 to be tried first. In the note accompanying the material on the Mufti, we insist that our friend should suggest that the Mufti be put on this list. He will do the same when the material on Eichmann will be sent to Washington. The material on Streicher and Eichmann will probably be sent Monday or Tuesday.
