Berlin, 24 September 1942.

SECRET!

Memorandum.

The Reich Foreign Minister has given me instructions today over the telephone to hurry as much as possible the evacuation of Jews from the various countries of Europe, because it is a known fact that the Jews stir up people against us everywhere and that they must be made responsible for attempts of murder and acts of sabotage. Upon a brief report concerning the present stage of evacuation of the Jews from Slovakia, Croatia, Roumania and the Occupied Territories the Reich Foreign Minister has given instructions now to start contacting the Governments of Bulgaria, Hungary and Denmark with the object of starting the evacuation of the Jews from these countries.

With regard to the settlement of the Jewish question in Italy the Reich Foreign Minister has reserved for himself all steps to be taken. This question shall be discussed personally either between the Fuehrer and the Duce or between the Reich Foreign Minister and Count Ciano.
