Telephone call for the Reich Minister

Strictly confidential

Today a session took place regarding the Jewish problem, General Fieldmarshal Goering presiding.

Results:

1. The aryazation of economy is to be speeded up. Settlement with Jews by means of book entry securities bearing interest. Sole exception in favor of promotion of export.
2. Expropriation of Jewish real estate, works of art, jewelry, shares, a.s.o. Question is to be referred to a small committee to be presided over by Reich Minister Funk.
3. Immediate examination by competent departments of the inner administration with regard to the question of forced labor of the Jewish proletariat, examination with regard to the question of restricting the free movement of Jews (ghettos) as well as a number of individual decrees such as forbidding the visit of spas, swimming pools, forests, the use of sleeping cars, the attendance of German schools by Jewish children a.s.o.
4. Forbidding of attendance of theaters, concerts, picture shows a.s.o. by Jews (Already promulgated by an immediate decree of Reich Minister Goebbels).
5. Levying of a single contribution of one billion Reichsmark upon German Jews (already published)
6. Emigration of Jews is to be promoted in every way.
7. The damage arising from the action taken against the Jews in the last few days is to be charged to the Jews in a way yet to be determined. The question of the effect upon insurance policies a.s.o. has been discussed and is the object of further examination.
8. Reich Governors and party offices are to be informed that arbitrary actions are strictly forbidden.
9. I have announced the question of the treatment of foreign Jews and safeguarded the participation of the foreign office in all measures, generally and individually. Our starting point is that foreign nations are only to be taken into consideration if prevailing interests of the Reich compel us to do so. Promise that contractual obligations will be taken into consideration.
